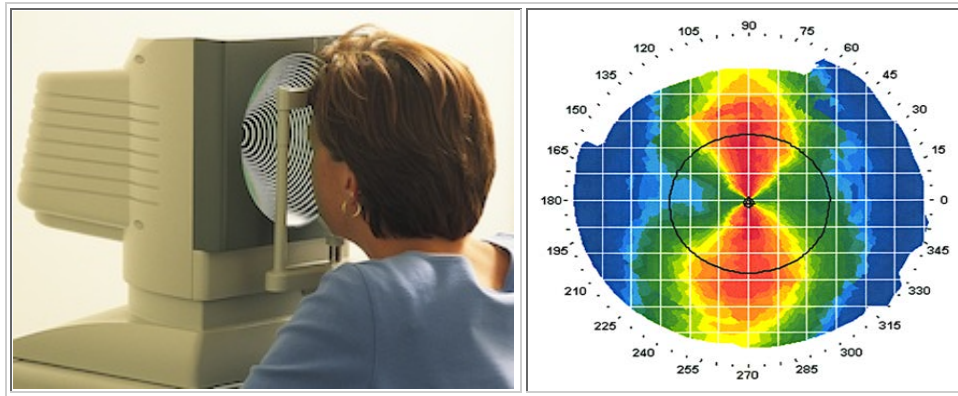


Corneal Topography

We use topography to detect corneal disease such as keratoconus and early forms of corneal ectasia (progressive corneal thinning and irregular astigmatism). Other causes of corneal astigmatism can be explored with topography too: corneal scars, pterygiums, corneal transplants, and corneal sutures.
