
Pterygium Surgery with Conjunctival Graft

A pterygium is a growth on the surface of the cornea that can cause irregular astigmatism and even grow into the visual axis (central vision). They are usually the result of sundamage. In pterygium surgery, we remove this growth and replace it with a graft of healthy cells.
